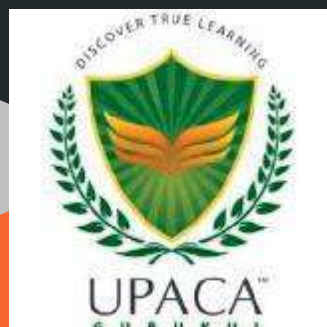

Admission in process -for 2017-2018

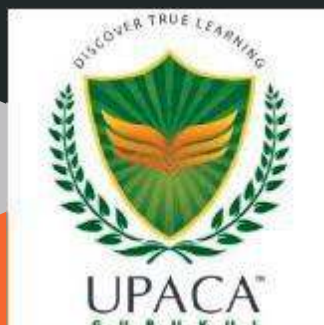


CPT RESULT

The time to recall the efforts and share the proud, thankful and relieved moment and taking the stillness to hear our students express their achievements earned.

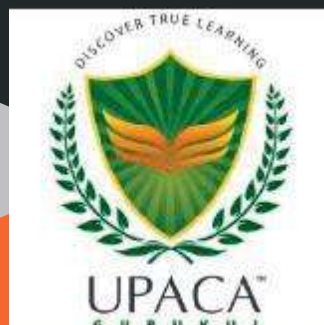

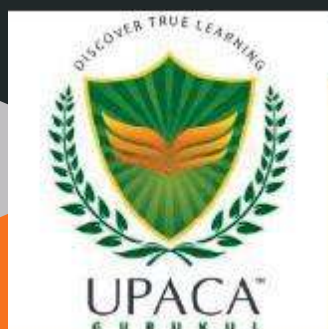
THE GRADUATE PROGRAM

Yet, another itinerary one of the milestone that is to be achieved. The academic standing will surely tell how one has progressed towards completion of the syllabus.



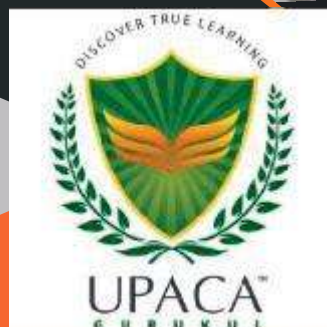
IPCC MAY 2017 ENGAGEMENTS

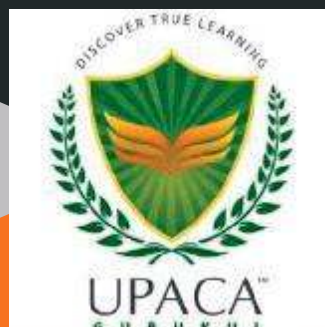
OUR GUEST

Variety is the spice of life. Students are enthusiastic when they enjoy playing games and immerse themselves enriching their experiences.

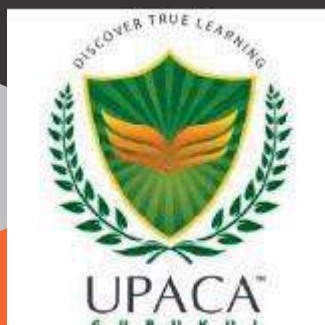
